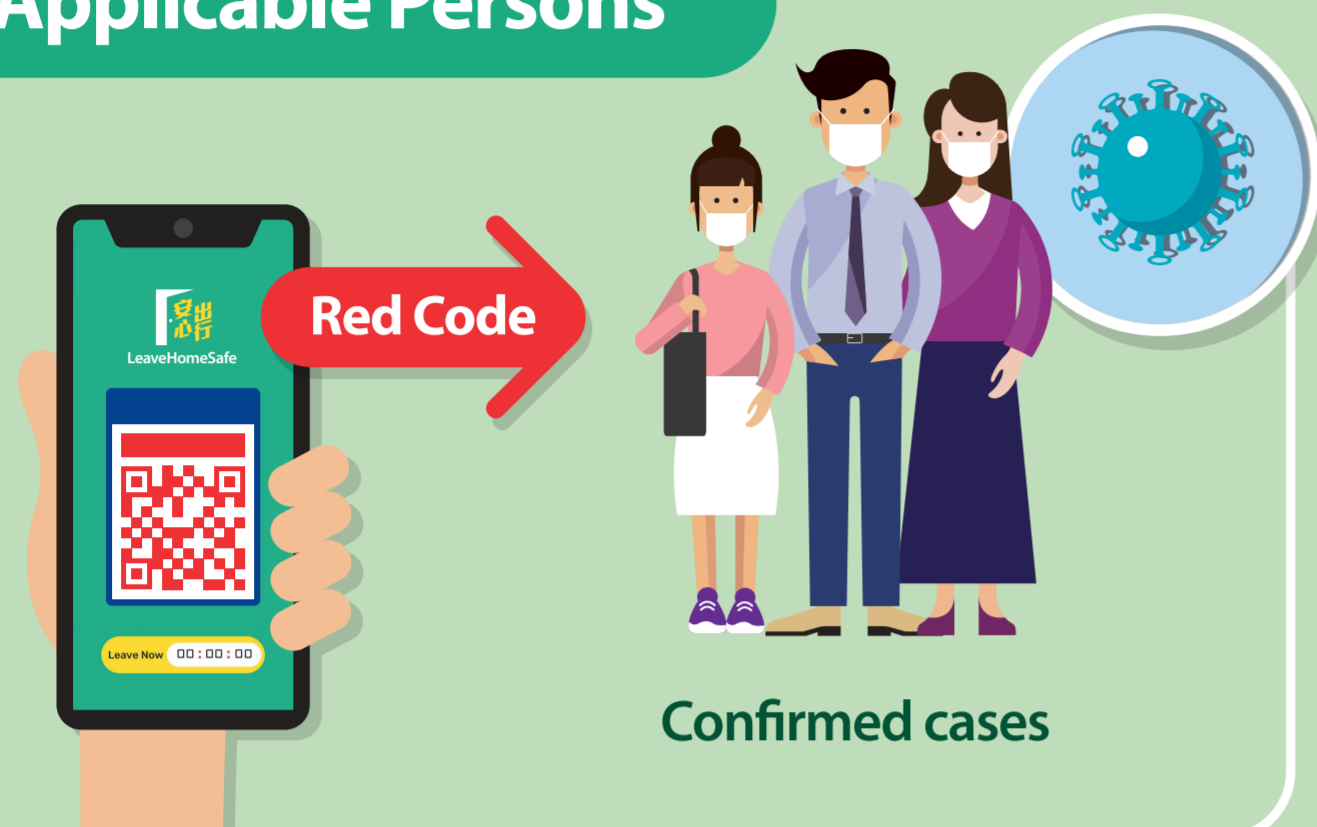
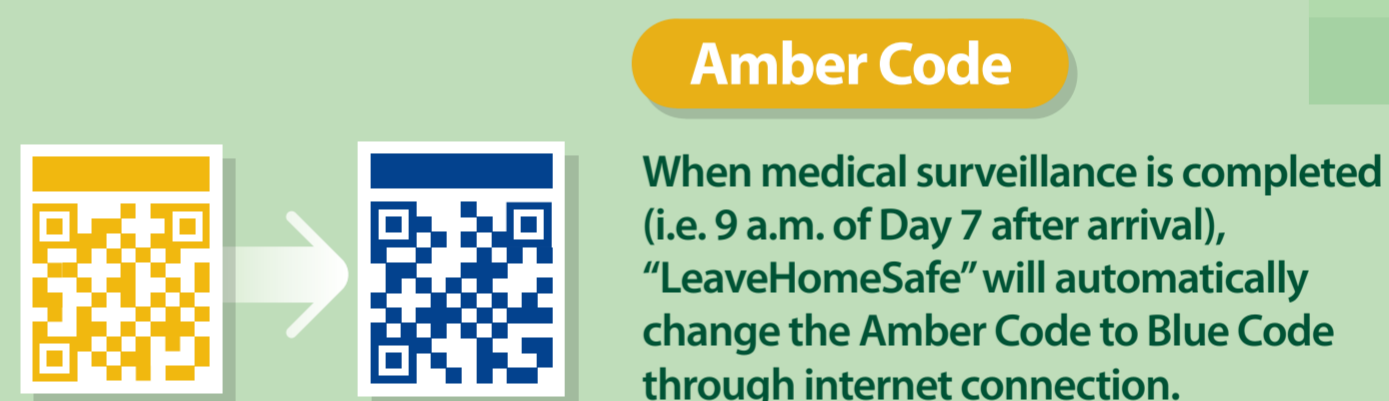


Enhanced Vaccine Pass Function – Red Code and Amber Code

Persons Who Belong to the Category of Amber Code

- Not allowed to enter the following premises (except for working at the premises, or order for takeaway of food or drink) in the capacity of a customer or visitor : catering premises (including bars or pubs), amusement game centres, bathhouses, fitness centres, places of amusement, places of public entertainment, party rooms, beauty parlours, club houses, clubs or nightclubs, karaoke establishments, mahjong-tin kau premises, massage establishments, sports premises, swimming pools, cruise ships, event premises, barber shops or hair salons, religious premises
- Not allowed to enter other premises (except for working or attending school at the premises) requiring key protection (designated healthcare premises, RCHDs and RCHEs and schools)
- May take transports, as well as enter shopping malls and supermarkets to obtain daily necessities
- Allowed to participate in B2B conventions and exhibitions subject to specified requirements (Note 2)

Persons Who Belong to the Category of Red Code

- Not allowed to leave the isolation location in accordance with their isolation orders, and not allowed to enter all the premises listed in item (i) above, hotels or guesthouses (except persons who are required to undergo isolation at relevant hotels or guesthouses in accordance with their isolation orders), shopping malls, department stores, markets and supermarkets.
- Not allowed to enter other premises requiring key protection (designated healthcare premises, RCHDs and RCHEs and schools)

Note 1 :

For persons who have received at least two doses of COVID-19 vaccines, completion of isolation refers to having negative rapid antigen test results on both Day 6 and Day 7 (or two consecutive days thereafter) with self-declaration made on the website (www.evt.gov.hk). Other persons are required to complete a 14-day isolation at the isolation site.

Note 2 : Relevant requirements include

- all participants therein must wear a mask at all times during the event, save for speaker(s) while delivering a speech,
- the event must be mostly B2B by nature, and
- the organiser must require pre-registration for all participants for entry to the premises.
