Exempted Persons	Examples
Children under the age of 12	Same as description
Persons holding a COVID-19 Medical Exemption Certificate	Same as description
Persons entering the specified premises only for placing an order for takeaway of food or drink, or taking such food or drink	Persons picking up takeaway food ordered from a restaurant
Persons entering the specified premises only for delivering or picking up an article on the premises	Persons delivering merchandise to supermarkets
Persons entering the specified premises only for performing necessary repairs on the premises	Persons repairing the stove of a restaurant
Persons entering or passing through the specified premises only for receiving vaccination, medical treatment or undergoing a compulsory test under Cap. 599J	Persons receiving medical treatment at a clinic located in a shopping mall
Persons entering or passing through the specified premises only for receiving essential government service	Persons renewing their drivers' licence at a government premises located in a shopping mall
Persons entering or passing through the specified premises only for appearing as a party to any court proceedings	Persons passing through a shopping mall in order to enter a court located in the same building as the shopping mall
Persons entering the specified premises to avoid any physical harm to the persons or any other persons inside the premises	Persons providing first aid to another person in the premises
Persons entering the specified premises as required by a public officer	Persons following directions of police officers
Persons entering or remaining on the specified premises with lawful authority or reasonable excuse	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Persons working as bailiffs entering the specified premises • Persons passing through a shopping mall for the purpose of travelling to and from his/her home or place of work
